Your Rights under the Family and Medical Leave Act

Reasons for Taking Leave:

- To care for the individual's child who falls in the United States Armed Forces.
- To care for the individual's spouse, parent, or next of kin who is unable to care for himself or herself because of a serious health condition.
- To care for the individual's child who is a full-time student at an institution of higher education.
- To care for the individual's child who is a full-time student at an institution of higher education and is the only child of the individual who is a full-time student at an institution of higher education.

Unlawful Acts by Employers:

- To discriminate against an employee for taking FMLA leave.
- To interfere with, restrain, or deny the exercise of any rights provided by FMLA.
- To discharge an employee for taking FMLA leave.
- To threaten to discharge an employee for taking FMLA leave.
- To threaten to take any other adverse action against an employee for taking FMLA leave.

Advance Notice and Medical Certification:

Employees must provide advance notice to their employers of their intent to take FMLA leave. Employees must also provide their employers with a medical certification from a health care provider.

Job Benefits and Protection:

Employees who take FMLA leave are entitled to the same job and benefits as if they had not taken leave.

FAIR EMPLOYMENT LAW

The Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA) prohibits employers from discriminating on the basis of race, sex, religion, national origin, ancestry, marital status, age, or disability.

FEHA APPLIES:

- To all employers with one or more employees.
- To all employers with one or more employees who are covered by the California Labor Code.

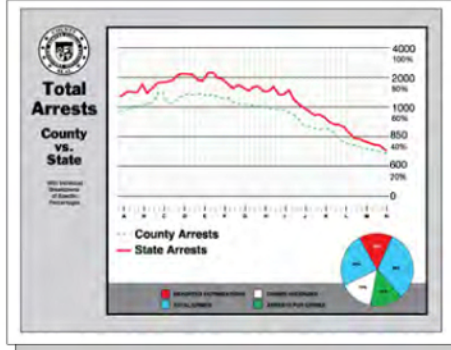
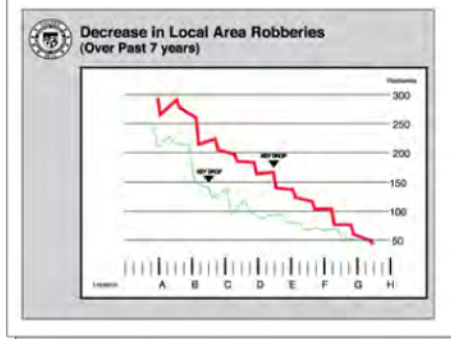
