WORKERS' COMPENSATION NOTICE

THE EMPLOYEE SHOULD:

1. Immediately give notice to the employer, in writing, if you have an occupational injury and the date of accident or notice of the occupational disease.
2. Notify your supervisor and the employer of the injury or occupational disease as soon as possible.
3. Obtain medical treatment as soon as possible.
4. Report the injury to the Commission through your supervisor or directly to the Commission.

THE EMPLOYER SHOULD:

1. Immediately give notice to the Commission of the injury or occupational disease.
2. Obtain medical treatment for the injured worker.
3. Report the injury to the Commission through your supervisor or directly to the Commission.

DRESS CODE

The dress code is not meant to restrict personal freedom of expression, but to promote a professional appearance.
